RESOLUTION NO. 2018-20

RESOLUTION WAIVING ASSESSMENT INTEREST FOR THE CURB AND SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR PARCEL 06.34.457.007; WITHIN THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, BUCHANAN COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, heretofore and in strict compliance with Chapter 384 of the Code of Iowa, the City Council of the City of Independence, Iowa, did, pursuant to a Resolution of Necessity duly adopted, order the construction of the Curb and Sidewalk Replacement Project, such improvement having been duly completed, the work accepted and the Project Engineers having filed the final assessment schedule, which has been fully considered by this Council;

WHEREAS, a property owned by Buchanan County was inadvertently placed on the assessment roles and charged a finance charge for Curb and Sidewalk Replacement;

NOW, THEREFORE, It Is Resolved by the City Council of the City of Independence, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The final assessment schedule will be modified to remove the finance charge associated with Parcel Number 06.34.457.007 for this assessment;


