

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09

A RESOLUTION PUSUANT TO SECTION 384.42 OF THE IOWA CODE COVERING THE 2020 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the City Council of the City of Independence, Iowa (the “City”) that the 2020 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (the “Project”) be constructed in the City in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 384 of the Code of Iowa and that a portion of the cost of the Project be assessed to the property benefited thereby; and

WHEREAS, the City has arranged for engineering services for the Project with Crawford Engineering & Surveying, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Independence, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The Project shall consist of Crack and Seat and Asphaltic Cement Concrete (ACC) overlay of existing Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) Pavement on and along the following segments of street and avenue in the City of Independence, Buchanan County, Iowa:

- Bland Boulevard SW from a point approximately 51 feet west of its centerline intersection with 6th Avenue SW on the east to a point 15 feet east of its centerline intersection with Liberty Trail on the west.
- 2nd Street SW from its intersection with 4th Avenue SW on the east to its intersection with 6th Avenue SW on the west.
- 12th Street NE from its intersection with 5th Avenue NE on the east to and including its intersection with 1st Avenue NE on the west.
- 4th Avenue NW from its intersection with 1st Street West on the south to its intersection with 3rd Street NW on the north.
- 3rd Street NW from its intersection with 4th Avenue NW on the east to its intersection with 6th Avenue NW on the west.
- 3rd Street SE from its intersection with 7th Avenue SE on the east to its intersection with 5th Avenue SE on the west.
- 8th Avenue NE from its intersection with 11th Street NE on the south to its intersection with 12th Street NE on the north.

Section 2. It is considered that the properties abutting the above-described segments of street to be improved will be specially benefitted by this improvement and should be specially assessed.

Section 3. The Project Engineers are hereby ordered to prepare preliminary plans and specifications, an estimated total cost of the work and a plat and schedule and to file the same with the City Clerk.

Section 4. The improvement shall be known as the “2020 Pavement Rehabilitation Project,” and shall be so referred to in all subsequent proceedings.

Section 5. All resolutions, parts of resolutions, or actions of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.

Resolution No. 2020-09 was passed and approved by a majority vote of the City Council of Independence, Iowa, on the 27th day of January, 2020.
