RESOLUTION NO. 2021-03

A RESOLUTION TO SET YEARLY MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT RATE WHEN A CITY EMPLOYEE UTILIZES A PERSONAL VEHICLE FOR CITY BUSINESS; WITHIN THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, BUCHANAN COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Independence met in regular session on Monday, January 11, 2021 and by majority vote approved and authorized the Yearly Mileage Reimbursement Rate when a City Employee Utilizes a Personal Vehicle for City Business; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Independence City Council to set a rate of mileage reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Independence, Iowa, has set the rate at 56 cents per mile to reimburse employees for use of their personal vehicle for city business; and

WHEREAS, this rate is set forth by the Internal Revenue Service and is the standard mileage rate for businesses based on an annual study of the fixed and variable costs of operating an automobile; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, IOWA met in City Hall Council Chambers on January 11, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. and by majority vote approved the Yearly Mileage Reimbursement Rate of 56 cents per mile for the calendar year beginning January, 2021.
